- 1 (A) THERE IS A CLASS B-DT (DINNER THEATER) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR 2 LICENSE.
- 3 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR THE USE OF A DINNER 4 THEATER THAT:
- 5 (1) PROVIDES LIVE MUSIC, ENTERTAINMENT, BROADWAY-STYLE 6 MUSICALS, COMEDY, DANCE PERFORMANCES, OR DRAMA TO THE DINNER 7 THEATER'S CUSTOMERS;
- 8 (2) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC BY RESERVATION ONLY; AND
- 9 (3) CONTAINS A DINING ROOM WITH FACILITIES FOR PREPARING AND SERVING FULL-COURSE MEALS FOR AT LEAST 80 INDIVIDUALS AT ONE SEATING.
- 11 (C) (1) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL AT 12 RETAIL FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION:
- 13 (I) BEER AND WINE BY THE DRINK OR BOTTLE; AND
- 14 (II) LIQUOR BY THE DRINK.
- 15 (2) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:
- 16 (I) FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION; OR
- 17 (II) AT ANY TIME EXCEPT IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DINNER
- 18 THEATER.
- 19 (D) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR BEGINNING 2
 20 HOURS BEFORE A LIVE PERFORMANCE UNTIL THE END OF THE PERFORMANCE ON
- 21 MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY.
- 22 (E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
