- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.

- This subtitle applies only to the licensee that is the Cecil County Breeders' Fair, Inc.,

AT LEAST \$1,800,000 TO THE FUND TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE PURPOSES

- 1 (F) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, THE
  2 DEPARTMENT MAY USE THE FUND TO PROVIDE A GRANT OR GRANTS TO A UNIT OF
  3 STATE GOVERNMENT, A LOCAL JURISDICTION, A NONPROFIT ENTITY, OR AN
  4 AFFILIATED FOUNDATION ESTABLISHED BY THE MARYLAND STADIUM AUTHORITY
  5 UNDER § 10–612 OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE, IF:
- 6 (1) THE DEPARTMENT HAS ENTERED INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
  7 GRANT RECIPIENT FOR THE ONGOING OPERATION, USE, MAINTENANCE,
  8 DEVELOPMENT, OR IMPROVEMENT OF THE GROUNDS AND FACILITIES WITHIN THE
  9 SPECIAL EVENT AREA AT FAIR HILL; AND
- 10 (2) THE GRANT FUNDS ARE RESTRICTED TO THE PURPOSES 11 REQUIRED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE GRANT AGREEMENT UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS 12 SUBSECTION AND THE GRANT RECIPIENT'S ASSOCIATED ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2022.
