- 15 (1) MAY OPERATE THE GOLF CART ONLY:
- 16 (I) ON A COUNTY HIGHWAY ON WHICH THE MAXIMUM POSTED
- 17 SPEED LIMIT DOES NOT EXCEED 35 MILES PER HOUR;
- 18 (II) BETWEEN DAWN AND DUSK; AND
- 19 (III) IF THE GOLF CART IS EQUIPPED WITH LIGHTING DEVICES
- 20 AS REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION;
- 21 (2) SHALL KEEP THE GOLF CART AS FAR TO THE RIGHT OF THE

- 24 (B) FREDERICK COUNTY MAY, BY LOCAL LAW:
- 25 (1) DESIGNATE COUNTY HIGHWAYS ON WHICH A PERSON MAY

- 27 (2) ESTABLISH FURTHER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS
- 28 FOR THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2022.
