- 2 (e) To close or gate an alley that is no longer needed for through pedestrian or 3 vehicular traffic, in order to promote the public health, safety, or welfare; [and]

- 6 (G) TO TOW VEHICLES BLOCKING ACCESS TO DRIVEWAYS, ALLEYS, TRANSIT 7 LANES, OR PARKING FACILITIES.
