(a) $\mathbf{2}$ (f) "Child in need of assistance" means a child who requires court intervention 3 because: The child has been abused, has been neglected, has a developmental 4 (1)disability, or has a mental disorder; and $\mathbf{5}$ 6 The child's parents, guardian, or custodian are unable or unwilling to (2)7 give proper care and attention to the child and the child's needs. 8 (s)(1) "Neglect" means the leaving of a child unattended or other failure to 9 give proper care and attention to a child by any parent or individual who has permanent or 10 temporary care or custody or responsibility for supervision of the child under circumstances 11 that indicate: 12That the child's health or welfare is harmed or placed at [(1)] **(I)** substantial risk of harm; or 1314That the child has suffered mental injury or been placed at [(2)] **(II)** 15substantial risk of mental injury. 16 (2) "NEGLECT" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE MERE USE OF MARIJUANA BY 17ANY PARENT OR INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY CARE OR 18CUSTODY OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR SUPERVISION OF THE CHILD UNLESS, AS A 19 **RESULT OF THE USE OF MARIJUANA:** 20THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE IS HARMED OR PLACED **(I)** 21AT SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF HARM; OR 22**(II)** THE CHILD HAS SUFFERED MENTAL INJURY OR BEEN PLACED AT SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF MENTAL INJURY. 2324SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25October 1, 2022.
