CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Environment - Permit Applications - Environmental Justice Screening

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person applying for a certain permit from the Department 4 of the Environment to include in the application the EJ Score from the Maryland EJScreen mapping EJ tool for the address census tract where the applicant is 5 6 seeking the permit; requiring the Department, on receiving a certain permit 7 application, to conduct review an environmental justice analysis of the address 8 <u>census tract</u> where the applicant is seeking a permit using the Maryland EJScreen 9 mapping EJ tool; requiring the Department to conduct the analysis before deciding 10 whether to issue a permit; requiring notices regarding certain permit applications to 11 include information related to EJ Scores and environmental justice analyses; and 12 generally relating to environmental permits and environmental justice screenings.
