1 AN ACT concerning 2 Maryland Stadium Authority - Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events 3 Facility - Alterations 4 FOR the purpose of altering the entity with which the Maryland Stadium Authority must 5 enter into a written operating agreement before issuing bonds to finance the 6 **Facility** Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events 7 Hagerstown-Washington County Industrial Foundation to The Hagerstown 8 Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility, Inc.; and generally relating to the 9 Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility. 10 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, 11 Article – Economic Development 12 Section 10–646.2(a) Annotated Code of Maryland 13 (2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) 14 15 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 16 Article – Economic Development 17 Section 10–646,2(e), (f), and (g) Annotated Code of Maryland 18 (2018 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) 19 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 21That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 22 Article - Economic Development



- 1 (a) Except as authorized by § 10–639 of this subtitle, to finance site acquisition, 2 design, and construction of any segment of the Hagerstown Multi–Use Sports and Events 3 Facility, the Authority shall comply with this section.
- 4 (e) The Authority may not issue bonds to finance the Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility until the Authority and [the Hagerstown-Washington County Industrial Foundation] THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC., secure a written operating agreement.
- 8 (f) The Authority shall secure a written agreement to transfer ownership of the 9 Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility from the Authority to [the 10 Hagerstown-Washington County Industrial Foundation] THE HAGERSTOWN 11 MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC., as approved by the Board of Public Works:
- 13 (1) in which [the Hagerstown–Washington County Industrial Foundation]
 14 THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC., agrees to:
- 15 (i) own, market, promote, and operate or contract for the marketing, 16 promotion, and operation of the Hagerstown Multi–Use Sports and Events Facility in a 17 manner that maximizes the Facility's economic return; and
- 18 (ii) to maintain and repair or contract for the maintenance and 19 repair of the Hagerstown Multi–Use Sports and Events Facility so as to keep the 20 Hagerstown Multi–Use Sports and Events Facility in first–class operating condition;
- 21 (2) that includes provisions:
- (i) protecting the investments of the Authority and [the Hagerstown-Washington County Industrial Foundation] THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC., in the Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility;
- 26 (ii) requiring [the Hagerstown-Washington County Industrial 27 Foundation] **THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC.,** 28 to contribute to a capital improvement reserve fund an amount sufficient to keep the 29 Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility in first-class operating condition;
- 30 (iii) requiring [the Hagerstown-Washington County Industrial 31 Foundation] **THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC.,** 32 to be solely responsible for all expenditures relating to the operation of the Hagerstown 33 Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility that may be incurred, including operating deficits; 34 and
- 35 (iv) allowing [the Hagerstown–Washington County Industrial Foundation] THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY, INC.,

- to keep all operating profits resulting from the operation of the Hagerstown Multi–Use Sports and Events Facility each year; and
- 3 (3) to be solely responsible for all expenditures relating to the operation, 4 maintenance, and repair of the Hagerstown Multi–Use Sports and Events Facility that may 5 be incurred, including the amount by which expenditures exceed revenues.
- 6 (g) On or before December 31 each year, [the Hagerstown–Washington County 7 Industrial Foundation] THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS 8 FACILITY, INC., shall report to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House 9 Appropriations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the Facility's assessment of the maintenance and repair needed to keep the Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and Events Facility in operating order.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
