- 21 (a) In addition to the other qualifications for a license set forth in this subtitle, an
- 22 applicant shall qualify under this section by meeting the educational and experience
- 23 requirements set forth in subsection (b), (c), or (d) of this section.
 - (d) (1) An applicant qualifies under this section if the applicant:

1	(i) subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, has at least 12 years
2	of work experience in engineering that is satisfactory to the Board and that indicates to the
3	Board that the applicant may be competent to practice engineering; and

- 4 (ii) 1. has passed the examination IN THE FUNDAMENTALS OF ENGINEERING GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 6 2. AFTER PASSING THE EXAMINATION IN THE 7 FUNDAMENTALS OF ENGINEERING, HAS PASSED THE EXAMINATION in the principles 8 and practice of engineering given by the Board under this subtitle.
- 9 (2) If an applicant has completed 1 or more years of a college or university 10 curriculum in engineering that the Board approves, it may allow, for each of those years, a 11 1-year credit towards the experience requirement of paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection.
- 12 (3) If an applicant has completed 1 or more years of a college or university 13 curriculum in engineering that has not been approved by the Board, the Board may allow, 14 for each of those years, a credit of up to 6 months towards the experience requirement under 15 paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2022.
