6 the annual budget bill an appropriation to the Department of Planning to be used as
7 a grant to the Maryland Humanities Council for a certain grantmaking initiative;
8 and generally relating to an appropriation for a grantmaking initiative.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

17 **5–206.**

18 **FOR EACH ~~FISCAL YEAR~~ OF FISCAL YEARS 2024 AND 2025, THE GOVERNOR**
19 **SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 TO**
