## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Wicomico County – Orphans’ Court – Salary of Orphans’ Court Judges**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the salary of a judge of the Orphans’ Court of Wicomico  
4 County; and generally relating to the Orphans’ Court of Wicomico County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
6 Article – Estates and Trusts  
7 Section 2–108(v)  
8 Annotated Code of Maryland  
9 (2017 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Estates and Trusts**

13 2–108.

14 (v) (1) Each judge of the Court for Wicomico County shall receive an annual  
15 salary of ~~[\$9,500]~~ **\$11,600** to be paid quarterly.

16 (2) Each judge shall also receive an annual allowance for traveling  
17 expenses of \$1,560 to be paid quarterly.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35  
2 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary  
3 or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court of Wicomico County while serving in a  
4 term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act  
5 concerning the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court of Wicomico County  
6 shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does  
7 not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out  
8 an unexpired term.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
10 October 1, 2022.
