BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Estates and Trusts Section 2-108(v)Annotated Code of Maryland (2017 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Estates and Trusts** 2-108. (v) Each judge of the Court for Wicomico County shall receive an annual (1)salary of [\$9,500] **\$11,600** to be paid quarterly. Each judge shall also receive an annual allowance for traveling (2)expenses of \$1,560 to be paid quarterly.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court of Wicomico County while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court of Wicomico County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2022.
