3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension 4 System for certain local law enforcement officers of the Crisfield Police Department $\mathbf{5}$ under certain circumstances; providing that a certain individual is entitled to 6 eligibility service and creditable service that was earned before the effective date of 7 the Crisfield Police Department's participation in the Law Enforcement Officers' 8 Pension System; providing that an individual who receives certain service credit is 9 not a member of and has no rights to a benefit in the Employees' Pension System; 10 providing for the transfer of creditable service for a certain individual; providing for 11 the transfer and crediting of certain assets on the effective date of participation; and generally relating to the Crisfield Police Department's participation in the Law 1213 Enforcement Officers' Pension System.
