17 (g) When the governing body of a county or municipal corporation becomes the 18 holder of a certificate of sale purchased in accordance with § 14–824 of this subtitle, the 19 governing body of the county or municipal corporation may file a complaint, at any time 20 after the date of sale, to foreclose all rights of redemption in [abandoned property consisting 21 of:
