## SENATE SIMPLE RESOLUTION

1 A Senate Simple Resolution concerning

## Implementation of Modified Procedures Due to COVID-19

- FOR the purpose of implementing modified procedures for the Senate of Maryland due to COVID-19.
- WHEREAS, The federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Maryland Department of Health continue to advise residents of the State to take precautions, including getting vaccinated, wearing masks, and keeping at least 6 feet of distance from others, to slow the spread of COVID-19; and
- 9 WHEREAS, As of January 6, 2022, there have been over 776,200 confirmed cases of and almost 11,800 confirmed deaths from COVID-19 in the State; and
- WHEREAS, Hospitalizations due to COVID-19 continue to put a strain on the State's health care system, with the daily count of hospitalizations increasing from 742 on December 1, 2021, to over 3,000 on January 4, 2022; and
- WHEREAS, A state of emergency and the existence of a catastrophic health emergency was again declared for the State on January 4, 2022, due to the spread of COVID-19; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, That due to the continuing spread of COVID-19, there remains a necessity to implement modified procedures to protect the health or safety of the members of the Senate of Maryland, their staff, and the public; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That Rule 118 of the Senate of Maryland Rules now applies.
