10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
Adventist HealthCare Fort Washington Medical Center is a 37-bed hospital located just south of National Harbor in a growing section of the region. It cares for over 23,000 patients annually in its Emergency department and, like Adventist healthcare, has a strong commitment to serving the needs of their community. Adventist Healthcare Fort Washington Medical Center serves patients in Fort Washington, Oxon Hill, Temple Hills area as well as parts of Southeast Washington, DC. The hospital provides general inpatient services and operates one of the busiest emergency rooms in the metropolitan area.					

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Expanding the Electrical Capacity: Following a building spatial and utilization analysis, we learned that our current emergency generator is at maximum capacity, prohibiting us from adding the most basic and essential diagnostic equipment such as an MRI Machine. We are the only hospital in the state of Maryland without an MRI machine. Typically, hospitals that provide emergency services operate at least two CT scanners and an MRI machine. FWMC has only one aging CT machine, which greatly restricts the care we provide to the more than 30,000 patients who rely on our emergency department each year. Renovate Inpatient Rooms: As an older and undersized facility with all semiprivate rooms, it is paramount that we create a compassionate healing environment for our patients. This poses a significant challenge as our in-patient rooms and nursing station have not been upgraded for more than 30 years.
