The coronavirus pandemic materialized in	January 2020 in	est as Fort Washington Medical			

The coronavirus pandemic materialized in January 2020, just as Fort Washington Medical Center (FWMC) recently joined the Adventist HealthCare system in October 2019. The acquisition was pivotal for the hospital because it meant that additional critical resources to safely care for patients were on the horizon. While the hospital originally built as an emergency room in 1983 - provided high-quality healthcare services, operating as a standalone community hospital had proven to be challenging given the changes in health care both nationally and in Maryland. The vast resources that Adventist HealthCare would provide would enable more efficient care as part of Marylands Total Cost of Care initiative.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

An \$800,000 grant would support the purchase of necessary equipment that is outdated or nonexistent. Part of our strategic plan is to establish an economies of scale system whereby we would apply a multi-specialty, and fiscally conservative approach to equipment purchases. As we continue to grow, and as we address our immediate surgical and patient needs, the idea is to determine how many machines can be shared among the various specialties. For example, we are currently in need of various imaging equipment such as fluoroscopic C-arms and radiolucent surgical tables. This efficient c-shaped imaging scanner intensifier has radiographic capabilities used to help make more accurate and faster diagnoses. The C-arm and tables would be used by various specialists including, orthopedic, cardiac, bariatric, urology, interventional radiology, vascular, and more. It also would be used by our emergency medicine physicians.
