The City of Aberdeen is a full-service municipality located in Harford County, MD. The City has a population of 16,254 (U.S. Census, 2020). The City of Aberdeen is committed to providing recreational opportunities for the community and will maintain the Grasmere Park if funded. The City has administered numerous federal, state, and county grants over the years for public improvements and has the staff to fulfill the grant reporting requirements.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The City of Aberdeen is requesting funding to construct a pocket park on Grasmere Drive in the Windemere Estates subdivision located off Paradise Road. The Grasmere Drive pocket park is approximately 0.16 acres in area located off Grasmere Drive on a vacant asphalt turnaround roadway adjacent to a platted open space and wooded area. This is a densely populated area of the City with road connections leading to Paradise Road, Hillcrest Drive, and MD 22. There are over 200 residential dwellings located in the Windemere Estates/Hillcrest Manor subdivisions with a diverse population including younger children and seniors. There are no other municipal or privately owned, public open spaces or recreational areas within walking distance of the Grasmere Drive site. The funding if awarded would be used for purchase of playground equipment, landscaping, hardscape with pavers, benches, picnic tables, and trash receptacles.
