<p>Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS), one of the nation's 20th largest school districts, has 208 schools and centers, more than 136,500 students and nearly 22,000 employees. The school system serves a diverse student population from urban, suburban and rural communities located in the Washington, DC suburbs. PGCPS is nationally recognized for college and career-readiness programs that provide students with unique learning opportunities, including dual enrollment and language immersion.</p>

The description of the project is to provide a new school marquee sign, inclusive of an electronic video messaging display. The purpose of the installation of a new electronic sign is to provide the school with an integral tool to increase communication between the school and community. The electronic marquee sign will provide an opportunity to increase awareness of school events such as graduations, sporting events, PTA meetings, concerts, plays, etc. In addition the sign will provide an opportunity for the school to broadcast achievements. More importantly in the case of a potential school lock-down and/or emergency, the electronic sign provides another tool to communicate updates and critical information.
