Hampstead Elementary School PTO is a non-profit 501(c)3 Parent Teacher Organization whose mission is to support the community of students, teachers, and staff at Hampstead Elementary School. Hampstead Elementary School provides traditional Pre-K-5th Grade Education and is also home to one of Carroll Countys Autism Programs in which there are currently 4 classes enrolled, as well as other programs serving students with special needs such as Cerebral Palsy and Downs Syndrome, and a PREP Pre-School Program providing structured learning and social integration for 3 to 5-year-olds with cognitive disabilities.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Install a new playground at Hampstead Elementary School to replace an older/aging playground that doesn't fit the needs of all our students with a new inclusive playground that incorporates traditional play features such as climbing structures and slides, as well as ramps, sensory stations, wheelchair accessible structures, and poured rubber surfaces to allow all our students to be able to safely enjoy the playgrounds regardless of skill level or ability. Many of the students in our Autism and Special Needs programs have unique sensory and physical needs that our current playground cannot accommodate. We also have several wheelchair bound students who are unable to access our playground equipment since it is not handicapped accessible. Our goal, in partnership with the school, is to raise \$158,000 so we can first build a new K-5 inclusive playground, and then focus on raising funds to replace our Pre-K Playground.

28. Comments

We are requesting a Legislative Bond to help us raise the funds needed to replace our aging playgrounds with ones that meet current standards and that fit our schools unique needs. Hampstead Elementary School has 400+ students annually who will benefit from this new inclusive playground, and will also be adjacent to numerous community fields that are used for softball, baseball, soccer, and other rec sports. Families will be able to play and enjoy the equipment before, during, and after sporting events and practices, and the greater community will have access to use the playground during non-school hours, summers, and weekends.

Despite the pandemic and the challenges of the past 2 years - virtual and hybrid learning, and not being able to hold in person fundraisers - we are proud to say our PTO was able raise \$35,000 towards the playground, and we expect to be able to give another 5,000 towards it by the end of this school year. As you can imagine, we want the students whose families are investing in these playgrounds through our fundraisers to have use of them before aging out of elementary school. Thankfully, in addition to our PTO funds, the school was able to secure the Knorr Brake Company Grant for \$60,000, and financial support from other local businesses to get us to where we are now, which is about \$107,000.

Our goal, in partnership with the school, is to raise \$158,000 as soon as possible, so we can install the new K-5 inclusive playground first since it is the most used and most in need. Through our collective efforts of fundraising, grant writing, and community support we are happy to say the school was able to order the main playground equipment at the end of 2021 before 2022 price increases took effect, and the contractor agreed to store our equipment at no cost as we raise the remaining funds for installation. Once the main playground is complete, we plan to focus on our Pre-K Playground which will be an additional expense.

On behalf of our PTO, our School, our Students and Families, and our extended Community, thank you for your time and consideration of Hampstead Elementary School PTO and our vision of providing the students of Hampstead Elementary with playgrounds that all our students can enjoy.
