From 2019 through 2021 donated labor, materials and funds were used to replace the roof, flooring, interior painting, interior bathrooms, and A/C units to support our Veterans during COVID. Older Veterans rely on our post for meals, support for VA benefits and fellowship for their daily lives.

The 2022 Bond request is for replacement of the kitchen area including stove, deep fryer, coolers, deli coolers and refreshment coolers, along with improvements to the parking area, and outside restrooms. These improvements will support Veterans throughout the year.

The cost estimate is approximately \$55,000.00, and donated labor will aid with these projects.
