Al-Huda Inc formed in 1996 with the intention of building a community, education, and social service center for American-Muslims in the greater Washington DC metropolitan area. One of our major purposes has been to foster strong relationships between all segments of our diverse community, and this goal is being met everyday around our headquarters in College Park, Maryland. With our preK-12th grade Al-Huda School (500+ students) as the foundational project, Al-Huda is a very active part of the Prince Georges County non-profit, inter-faith, and social service sector. All year we plan and carry out food drives, free medical check-ups, clothing drives, vaccine clinics, refugee and immigrant services, interfaith socials and discussions, elder assistance programs, and many other programs.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Central to a vibrant, healthy community is a safe space where children and families can come together and spend time outdoors. Publicly accessible playgrounds are such spaces. College Park and the surrounding area have a dearth of modern, quality playgrounds that are safe and secure for families and their young children. The proposed project would establish such a playground on the campus of Al-Huda School in North College Park and would set times for the general public to enjoy using this playground. The playground would be ADA compliant, soft-surface, and aesthetically pleasing, and situated in a zero-traffic, wooded zone monitored by video surveillance and physical security provided by Al-Huda. The design would adhere to ASTMF 1487 and CPSC Playground Safety Standards. An investment in this project would benefit thousands of families and serve as a model of how the public wins when the State and Non-Profits form partnerships.
