The Calverton School seeks funding to repair and upgrade the HVAC system in one of its buildings and to replace two school building roofs on its 153-acre campus for safety reasons due to aging over time. *Gym (8,680 GSF) was constructed in 1973 and the roof was last renovated in 1994; roof to be repaired and upgraded. *Bowen Thomas Center (33,000 GSF) was constructed in 2001; roof to be repaired and upgraded. *Founders Hall (10,112 GSF) was constructed in 2007; current HVAC system to be repaired and upgraded with new boiler and reheat (to correct humidity issues by adding additional hot water coils in each air handler and piping).
