11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Town of Upper Marlboro is requesting assistance in funding Phase 2 and Phase 3 of its Upper Marlboro Community Playground project to construct a 15ft by 20 ft splash pad and a toddler playground. There are currently no public pools or aquatic recreational activities within the Town's limits, or in the greater Upper Marlboro area. The next closest public aquatic recreation opportunity is over 10 miles away. This splash pad will bring opportunities for children's sensory and mental growth to develop, families to come together and socialize, at a fraction of the cost to build and maintain a full pool facility. The splash pad will be maintained by the Town of Upper Marlboro Public Works Department. This playgrounds (and proposed splash pad) location is directly adjacent to the Sasscer Athletic Fields, the home to the Marlboro Boys & Girls Club (one of the largest in the State), which would allow a one-stop recreation opportunity for all ages.
