

Chapter 748

(House Bill 280)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class CT License

FOR the purpose of altering the requirements for premises for which a Class CT (cinema/theater) (on-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license may be issued in Washington County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Washington County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages

31–102.

This title applies only in Washington County.

31–1001.1.

(a) There is a Class CT (cinema/theater) (on-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license.

(b) The Board may issue the license for use in a cinema or theater that:

(1) is in a [stand-alone] building that is designed or used primarily for the exhibition of motion pictures to the public;

(2) has a capacity to hold at least 100 permanently installed seats; and

(3) has a minimum of six movie theater rooms.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
