## FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE First Reader

Senate Bill 102 (Senator Cassilly) Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

#### Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sale of Beer to Retail Dealer

This bill repeals, in Harford County, the prohibition on the sale of beer on credit to a retail dealer by holders of alcoholic beverages manufacturer's licenses or wholesaler's licenses. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2022.** 

### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** The bill is not anticipated to impact local finances or operations.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal overall, but potential meaningful impact on small businesses that are permitted to purchase or sell beer on terms other than for cash on delivery.

# **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Holders of alcoholic beverages manufacturer's licenses and wholesaler's licenses in Harford County may not sell beer to a retail dealer on terms other than cash on delivery. A civil action to enforce or collect a claim for credit extended or to enforce payment of a check given in violation of these prohibitions may not be maintained in the State.

If a holder of a wholesaler's license does sell beer to a retail dealer on terms other than for cash on delivery, the holder is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding two years or a fine up to \$1,000 or both. If a court imposes a penalty on an individual license holder who has obtained a license for or on behalf of a

corporation, a partnership, or an unincorporated association, if the penalty is a fine, the corporation, partnership, or unincorporated association is liable for the payment of the fine. If the penalty is imprisonment, the individual license holder must serve the term of imprisonment.
