Senate Bill 713

(Senator Reilly)

Anne Arundel County – Natural Resources – Fishing Gear

This bill authorizes the use of archery equipment to fish for northern snakehead in Anne Arundel County waters, subject to Department of Natural Resources (DNR) regulations. The bill makes the use of archery equipment to fish for northern snakehead (subject to DNR regulations) an exception to existing provisions that only allow fishing with a rod, or hook, and line, in specified waters of Anne Arundel County (mentioned under Current Law). **The bill takes effect June 1, 2022.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill does not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful.

Analysis

Current Law: In Anne Arundel County, a person may only fish with a rod, or hook, and line in (1) the waters of Coxes' Creek, Furnace Branch Creek, or Marley Creek above the B. and O. Bridge; (2) the waters of the Little Magothy River, the Magothy River, and their tributaries; (3) the waters of Bodkin Creek and specified tributaries; and (4) the waters of the Severn River or any creek, cove, tributary, or inlet of the Severn River.

Small Business Effect: DNR indicates that populations of northern snakeheads, a nonnative nuisance species, have increased in tidal rivers of the western shore of the Chesapeake Bay, and there has been increased interest by both recreational and commercial

harvesters to target those fish with archery equipment, a more efficient manner of harvesting northern snakeheads than hook and line. Small business commercial harvesters that take advantage of the bill's authorization to use archery equipment to fish for northern snakehead in Anne Arundel County waters may meaningfully benefit from increased harvest of northern snakeheads and associated sales of that harvest.
