Senate Bill 894 Judicial Proceedings (Senator Smith)

Commission on Judicial Disabilities - Release of Information - Criminal Activity

This bill requires the Commission on Judicial Disabilities, notwithstanding Maryland Rule 18-407, to provide information involving a judge's criminal activity to applicable law enforcement and prosecuting officials, including a grand jury if the information is requested by subpoena.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill does not materially affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect local government finances or operations.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: As authorized under §§ 4A and 4B of Article IV of the Maryland Constitution, the Commission on Judicial Disabilities investigates complaints against judges in the State's courts and recommends disciplinary action to the Court of Appeals, as appropriate.

Under Maryland Rule 18-407(b)(4)(A), the commission may provide information involving criminal activity, including information requested by subpoena from a grand jury, to applicable law enforcement and prosecuting officials.
