## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after "judges;" insert "<u>requiring the State Board of Elections</u> to reimburse each local board a certain amount of certain compensation that is paid to each returning election judge and to develop and implement a certain market <u>campaign</u>;".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 24, insert:

## "(C) <u>THE STATE BOARD SHALL REIMBURSE EACH LOCAL BOARD FOR \$50</u> OF THE EXTRA COMPENSATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(3)(II) OF THIS SECTION THAT IS PAID TO EACH RETURNING ELECTION JUDGE.

# (D) (1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND PROVIDE TO THE LOCAL BOARDS A MARKETING CAMPAIGN TO RECRUIT INDIVIDUALS TO SERVE AS ELECTION JUDGES IN POLLING PLACES IN THE STATE.
