<u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 390</u> (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, after the first "of" insert "<u>authorizing the State Board of</u> <u>Veterinary Medical Examiners to issue a license to an animal control facility to</u> <u>administer rabies vaccines:</u>"; in the same line, strike "State"; in the same line, strike "of Veterinary Medical Examiners"; and in line 17, after "2–304(f)" insert "<u>and 2–305</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 18, insert:

"<u>2–305.</u>

(a) <u>In this section, "animal control facility" means a humane society, as</u> <u>defined in § 10–601 of the Criminal Law Article, or a county or municipal designated</u> <u>animal shelter.</u>

(b) <u>The Board, on terms and conditions satisfactory to the Board, may issue a</u> <u>license to an animal control facility to allow the animal control facility to administer</u> [drugs]:

(1) DRUGS needed to sedate, euthanize, or sedate and euthanize animals; AND

(2) <u>RABIES VACCINES IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 18–313 OF THE</u> <u>HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE.</u>

(c) (1) (i) The owner of an animal control facility shall apply for the license.

(ii) <u>The Board shall issue a license in the name of the owner of an</u> animal control facility.

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(2) The application shall designate one individual at the facility responsible for the drugs AND RABIES VACCINES.

(3) The annual license fee is \$100.

(d) In accordance with procedures set out in § 2–311 of this subtitle, the Board may:

(1) Reject an application for a license; or

(2) Suspend or revoke a license for failure to comply with the Board's regulations.

(e) An animal control facility licensed under this section shall comply with the Board's requirements relating to employee training.

(f) <u>A member of the Board, or the Board's designated inspector, may enter an</u> <u>animal control facility licensed under this section at any reasonable hour to enforce the</u> <u>Board's regulations.</u>

(g) In consultation with the Maryland Department of Health, the Board shall adopt regulations necessary to carry out this section.".
