AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 430  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate Wilkins**” and substitute “**Delegates Wilkins, Kaufman, and Simmons**”; strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute “**Public Safety – Maryland State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy – Notification of Action Filed Against Police Officer**”; strike beginning with “specifying” in line 3 down through “liability” in line 11 and substitute “requiring a court to notify the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission of the filing of a certain civil action against a police officer at a certain time; and generally relating to the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission”; and strike in their entirety lines 12 through 26, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article – Public Safety

Section 3–219

Annotated Code of Maryland  
(2022 Replacement Volume)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 3 on page 2 through line 30 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

**“Article – Public Safety**

**3–219.**

**(A) A COURT SHALL NOTIFY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION OF THE FILING OF A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST A POLICE**

OFFICER INVOLVING ALLEGATIONS THAT THE POLICE OFFICER WRONGFULLY  
CAUSED THE DEATH OF OR SERIOUS BODILY INJURY TO AN INDIVIDUAL.

(B) THE COURT SHALL MAKE THE NOTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER  
SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE FILING OF THE  
CIVIL ACTION.”.

On page 3, in line 31, strike “3.” and substitute “2.”.
