AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1071
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 19, after “vessel;” insert “allowing a law enforcement officer to investigate a person for driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle or vessel while impaired by or under the influence of cannabis in certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 29, after “**(B)**” insert “**(1)**”.

On page 4, in lines 3 and 5, strike “**(1)**” and “**(2)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(I)**” and “**(II)**”, respectively; and after line 6, insert:

“(2) IF A PERSON IS THE ONLY OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE OR VESSEL, A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO DETECTS THE ODOR OF BURNT OR UNBURNT CANNABIS AFTER APPROACHING THE VEHICLE FOR A VALID STOP MAY DETAIN THE PERSON FOR DRIVING OR ATTEMPTING TO DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE OR VESSEL WHILE IMPAIRED BY OR UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF CANNABIS IN VIOLATION OF § 21-902 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OR § 8-738 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES ARTICLE BASED SOLELY ON THE ODOR OF BURNT OR UNBURNT CANNABIS.”
