## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 11

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "**Speed Limits** –" and substitute "**Establishment** of"; strike beginning with "altering" in line 3 down through "used;" in line 4 and substitute "requiring a school zone to be adjacent to a school, unless recommended by a traffic engineering study; prohibiting a school zone from exceeding a certain radius of any school or school activity, unless recommended by a traffic engineering study;"; and in line 5, strike "the enforcement of speed limits in" and substitute "establishing".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 20, after "(a)" insert "(1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

- (2) "SCHOOL" MEANS AN ACCREDITED PUBLIC, PAROCHIAL, OR PRIVATE LEARNING INSTITUTION OFFERING INSTRUCTION IN ANY GRADE FROM KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12.
- (3) "SCHOOL GROUNDS" MEANS SCHOOL PROPERTY THAT STUDENTS ROUTINELY OCCUPY WITHIN A SCHOOL ZONE.
  - (4) "SCHOOL-RELATED ACTIVITY" MEANS:
- (I) TRAVEL BY STUDENTS TO OR FROM SCHOOL ON FOOT OR BY BICYCLE; OR
- (II) THE DROPPING OFF OR PICKING UP OF STUDENTS BY SCHOOL BUSES OR OTHER VEHICLES.

- (5) "SCHOOL ZONE" MEANS A DESIGNATED ROADWAY SEGMENT WITHIN UP TO A 0.5-MILE RADIUS OF A SCHOOL:
- (I) APPROACHING, ADJACENT TO, AND BEYOND SCHOOL GROUNDS, OR IN AN AREA WHERE SCHOOL-RELATED ACTIVITY OCCURS;
- (II) ESTABLISHED BY OFFICIAL ACTION BY THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION OR A LOCAL AUTHORITY; AND
- (III) THAT IS APPROPRIATELY DESIGNATED BY SIGNS POSTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH:
- 1. THE MARYLAND MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES; AND
  - 2. STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION GUIDANCE.

**(B)**";

in the same line, strike "subsection (f)" and substitute "<u>PARAGRAPH (3)</u>"; in the same line, strike "section" and substitute "<u>SUBSECTION</u>"; and in line 21, strike "**0.1–MILE**" and substitute "<u>0.5–MILE</u>".

On page 2, in line 3, strike "(d)" and substitute "(E)"; after line 14, insert:

- "(3) (I) <u>UNLESS OTHERWISE RECOMMENDED BY A TRAFFIC</u> ENGINEERING STUDY, A SCHOOL ZONE:
  - 1. SHALL BE ADJACENT TO THE SCHOOL; AND

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- <u>2.</u> <u>MAY NOT EXCEED 500 FEET APPROACHING OR</u> BEYOND THE SCHOOL BUILDING OR SCHOOL GROUNDS.
- (II) IN ANY SCHOOL ZONE WHERE A SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD IS POSTED TO ASSIST STUDENTS IN CROSSING A HIGHWAY, THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT MAY NOT EXCEED 35 MILES PER HOUR IN THE SCHOOL ZONE DURING THE HOURS POSTED ON SIGNS DESIGNATING THE SCHOOL ZONE.";

and in lines 15 and 30, strike "(b)" and "(c)", respectively, and substitute "(C)" and "(D)", respectively.

On page 3, in lines 1 and 10, strike "(d)" and "(e)", respectively, and substitute "(E)" and "(F)", respectively; in line 11, strike "(d)" and substitute "(E)"; strike in their entirety lines 12 through 14, inclusive; in line 15, strike "(e)" and substitute "(F)"; and strike beginning with "means" in line 19 down through "vehicles" in line 24 and substitute "HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 21–803.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE".
