# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 253

(Third Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after the semicolon insert "<u>requiring the Department to</u> <u>require the operator of a farm to provide certain notice under certain circumstances</u>."

# AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "<u>MATERIAL</u>" in line 10 down through "<u>AND</u>" in line 11 and substitute "<u>SOURCE–SEPARATED ORGANIC MATERIAL BROUGHT ONTO</u> THE FARM AND COMMINGLED".

On page 5, in lines 20 and 21, in each instance, strike "FEEDSTOCK" and substitute "SOURCE-SEPARATED ORGANICS".

On page 6, after line 13, insert:

# "SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) This Act is not intended to alter the rules or requirements for farms or composting facilities operating without a composting permit in accordance with regulations in effect on January 1, 2023.
- (b) The Department of the Environment shall require the operator of a farm to provide written notice to the Department before conducting on—farm composting without a permit in accordance with this Act.";

and in line 14, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
