## <u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 913</u> (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "**Publicly**" in line 2 down through "**Definition**" in line 3 and substitute "<u>Education – Community Eligibility Provision Schools</u> and Prekindergarten Enrollment and Funding – Alterations"; strike beginning with "altering" in line 4 down through "language;" in line 7 and substitute "<u>exempting</u> certain schools from the requirement to collect a certain eligibility form if the school is in a local school system in which all schools participate in the community eligibility provision; altering the definition of "prekindergarten enrollment", beginning in a certain school year, to include certain Tier II children for certain funding purposes; altering the categories of certain Tier II children who are given priority for the expansion of prekindergarten slots; altering the categories of children who may be enrolled in a full– day prekindergarten program beginning in a certain school year;"; in line 8, strike "publicly funded full–day prekindergarten" and substitute "<u>community eligibility</u> provision schools and prekindergarten enrollment and funding"; in line 11, strike "5– 229(a)" and substitute "<u>5–229(b</u>"; in line 16, after "Section" insert "<u>5–222(c), 5–229(a)</u>."; and in the same line, strike "7–1A–04(a),".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 21, insert:

#### "<u>5–222.</u>

(c) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO SCHOOLS IN A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM THAT OPTED INTO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISIONS FOR ALL SCHOOLS IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM.

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(2) By school year 2022–2023, the State alternative income eligibility form shall be collected by each school that is participating in the United States Department of Agriculture community eligibility provision and may be collected by all other schools.

[(2)] (3) The State alternative income eligibility form shall be developed by the Department and shall include a statement indicating that the income information requested on the form is used to determine local and State funding for education.".

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 19, after "children" insert "<u>AND TIER II CHILDREN WHO ARE</u> <u>A PRIORITY UNDER § 7–1A–06(D) OF THIS ARTICLE</u>".

On page 4, in line 8, after "level;" insert "<u>OR</u>"; strike beginning with "WHO" in line 9 down through "(III)" in line 10; and strike beginning with "OR" in line 10 down through "LANGUAGE;" in line 12.

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 11 on page 5 through line 20 on page 6, inclusive.

# On page 6, in line 23, after "old" insert "<u>AND CHILDREN WHO ARE A PRIORITY</u> <u>UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION</u>".

On page 7, in lines 5, 6, and 10, in each instance, strike the bracket; in line 7, after "income;" insert "<u>OR</u>"; and strike beginning with "Homeless" in line 8 down through "(4)" in line 9.
