AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 765
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, before “**Alcoholic**” insert “**41st District –**”; strike beginning with “**Class**” in line 2 down through “**License**” in line 3 and substitute “**Licenses**”; in line 7, after “time;” insert “altering a certain period of time during which a certain alcoholic beverages license may be issued;”; and in line 15, after “12–902.1” insert “and 12–1001.4(a) and (d)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 17, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages

12–1001.4.

(a) In this section, “marketplace” means premises that:

(1) accommodate the public; and

(2) are made up of at least three food and beverage establishments, at least one of which is licensed to conduct off–premises sales, that opened to the public on or before July 1, 2022, or are expected to open within [6] 24 months of issuance of the marketplace license under this section.

(d) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor from one or more establishments within the marketplace by the drink or by the bottle for on-premises **OR OFF-PREMISES** consumption.”;

in line 18, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; in line 19, strike “It” and substitute “Section 1 of this Act”; in the same line, after “2024,” insert “Section 1 of”; and in line 21, after “effect.” insert “Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2025, Section 2 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
