AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 516

(First Reading File Bill)

On page 11, in line 7, strike “AND”; and in line 8, after “(2)” insert “THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, OR THE ADMINISTRATOR’S DESIGNEE; AND

(3)”.

On page 12, in line 2, strike “AND”; and in line 5, after “ARTICLE” insert “; AND

(IX) ONE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS A DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT”.

On page 64, after line 2 insert:

“(A) THE ADMINISTRATION, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, AND THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, SHALL STUDY IMPAIRED DRIVING RELATED TO CANNABIS USE.

(B) ON JULY 1, 2024, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER THROUGH JULY 1, 2028, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON:

(1) THE NUMBER OF IMPAIRED DRIVING CITATIONS AND ARRESTS RELATED TO CANNABIS USE IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR;

**(2) THE NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS RELATED TO CANNABIS USE IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR; AND**

**(3) THE NUMBER OF INJURIES AND DEATHS RESULTING FROM MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS RELATED TO CANNABIS USE IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR.**
