AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "**Grants**" insert "<u>and Pimlico Community</u> <u>Development Authority Membership</u>"; in line 4, after "City;" insert "<u>altering the</u> <u>appointment process for certain members of the Pimlico Community Development</u> <u>Authority:</u>"; and after line 5, insert:

"<u>BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,</u> <u>Article – Business Regulation</u> <u>Section 11–1201 and 11–1202</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2015 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement)

<u>BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u> <u>Article – Business Regulation</u> <u>Section 11–1203</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u>

(2015 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 12, insert:

"Article – Business Regulation

<u>11–1201.</u>

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

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(b) <u>"Authority" means the Pimlico Community Development Authority.</u>

(c) <u>"Park Heights Corridor" means the area designated as an urban renewal</u> <u>district in Baltimore City that is bounded by Northern Parkway on the north,</u> <u>Greenspring Avenue on the east, Druid Park Drive on the south, and the railroad tracks</u> <u>of the Western Maryland Railroad on the west.</u>

<u>11–1202.</u>

There is a Pimlico Community Development Authority.

<u>11–1203.</u>

- (a) <u>The Authority consists of the following 15 members:</u>
 - (1) the Baltimore City Planning Director;

(2) ten members, five of whom shall be business owners, residents, or service providers of the areas described in § 9–1A–31(a)(3)(ii) of the State Government Article, appointed by the Mayor of Baltimore City, [after consultation with the members of the Baltimore City Delegation in the General Assembly representing legislative districts 40 and 41] WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE;

(3) the State Senators representing legislative districts 40 and 41; and

(4) one State Delegate representing legislative district 40 and one State Delegate representing legislative district 41, each appointed by the Speaker of the House.

(b) <u>The Mayor of Baltimore City shall appoint the Chair of the Authority,</u> <u>subject to confirmation by the Baltimore City Council.</u>

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(c) (1) The term of a member appointed by the Mayor is 3 years.

(2) <u>The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms</u> provided for members on October 1, 2005.

(3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(4) <u>A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for</u> the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(5) <u>At the end of a term, resignation, or removal of a member, the Mayor</u> <u>shall appoint a new member to the Authority.</u>

(d) <u>A member may be removed by the Mayor for incompetence, misconduct, or</u> <u>failure to perform the duties of the position.</u>".
