<u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 299</u> (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "**Food Service Facilities**" and substitute "<u>Grocery</u> <u>Stores and Restaurants</u>"; in line 4, strike "owner and operator" and substitute "<u>owners and operators</u>"; in the same line, strike "a certain food service facility" and substitute "<u>certain grocery stores and restaurants</u>, beginning on a certain date,"; strike beginning with "develop" in line 5 down through "requirements" in line 6 and substitute "<u>place an automated external defibrillator in a certain area and maintain the functionality of the automated external defibrillator; granting certain immunities to grocery stores, restaurants, and individuals for certain acts or omissions under certain circumstances; altering the definition of "facility" for the purpose of excluding certain restaurants and grocery stores from the Public Access Automated External Defibrillator Program</u>"; in line 9, strike "food service facilities" and substitute "<u>grocery stores and</u> restaurants"; and after line 9, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Article - Education</u> <u>Section 13-517(a)</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2022 Replacement Volume)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 16, insert:

"Article – Education

<u>13–517.</u>

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(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) <u>"Automated external defibrillator (AED)" means a medical heart</u> monitor and defibrillator device that:

(i) <u>Is cleared for market by the federal Food and Drug</u> <u>Administration;</u>

(ii) <u>Recognizes the presence or absence of ventricular fibrillation</u> <u>or rapid ventricular tachycardia:</u>

(iii) <u>Determines, without intervention by an operator, whether</u> <u>defibrillation should be performed;</u>

(iv) On determining that defibrillation should be performed, automatically charges; and

(v) <u>1.</u> <u>Requires operator intervention to deliver the electrical</u> <u>impulse; or</u>

2. <u>Automatically continues with delivery of electrical</u>

<u>impulse.</u>

(3) <u>"Certificate" means a certificate issued by the EMS Board to a</u> registered facility.

(4) (I) "Facility" means an agency, association, corporation, firm, partnership, or other entity.

(II) <u>"FACILITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A GROCERY STORE OR</u> <u>RESTAURANT THAT IS SUBJECT TO § 21–330.3 OF THE HEALTH – GENERAL</u> <u>ARTICLE.</u>

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(5) "Jurisdictional emergency medical services operational program" means the institution, agency, corporation, or other entity that has been approved by the EMS Board to provide oversight of emergency medical services for each of the local government and State and federal emergency medical services programs.

(6) <u>"Program" means the Public Access Automated External</u> Defibrillator Program.

(7) <u>"Regional administrator" means the individual employed by the</u> Institute as regional administrator in each EMS region.

(8) <u>"Regional council" means an EMS advisory body as created by the</u> <u>Code of Maryland Regulations 30.05.</u>

(9) <u>"Regional council AED committee" means a committee appointed by</u> the regional council consisting of:

- (i) <u>The regional medical director;</u>
- (ii) The regional administrator; and
- (iii) Three or more individuals with knowledge of and expertise in

AEDs.

(10) <u>"Registered facility" means an organization, business association,</u> agency, or other entity that meets the requirements of the EMS Board for registering with the Program.";

after line 18, insert:

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"(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)" MEANS A MEDICAL HEART MONITOR AND DEFIBRILLATOR DEVICE THAT:

(I) IS CLEARED FOR MARKET BY THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION;

(II) <u>RECOGNIZES THE PRESENCE OR ABSENCE OF</u> <u>VENTRICULAR FIBRILLATION OR RAPID VENTRICULAR TACHYCARDIA;</u>

(III) DETERMINES, WITHOUT INTERVENTION BY AN OPERATOR, WHETHER DEFIBRILLATION SHOULD BE PERFORMED;

(IV) ON DETERMINING THAT DEFIBRILLATION SHOULD BE PERFORMED, AUTOMATICALLY CHARGES; AND

(V) 1. <u>Requires operator intervention to deliver</u> <u>The electrical impulse; or</u>

2. <u>Automatically continues with delivery of</u> <u>The electrical impulse.</u>

(3) "GROCERY STORE" MEANS A STORE THAT HAS:

(I) ALL MAJOR FOOD DEPARTMENTS, INCLUDING PRODUCE, MEAT, SEAFOOD, DAIRY, AND CANNED AND PACKAGED GOODS; OR SB0299/243528/01Finance CommitteeAmendments to SB 299Page 5 of 6

(II) <u>1.</u> <u>AT LEAST ONE OF THE MAJOR FOOD</u> <u>DEPARTMENTS; AND</u>

<u>2.</u> AT LEAST 10,000 SQUARE FEET OF FLOOR SPACE.";

in lines 19 and 21, strike "(A)" and "(B)" respectively, and substitute "<u>(B)</u>" and "<u>(C)</u>" respectively; in line 20, strike "**\$400,000**" and substitute "<u>**\$1,000,000**</u>"; and in line 21, strike "THE" and substitute "<u>BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, EACH</u>".

On page 1 in lines 19 and 21, and on page 2 in line 6, in each instance, strike "FOOD SERVICE FACILITY" and substitute "<u>GROCERY STORE OR RESTAURANT</u>".

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with "DEVELOP" in line 22 on page 1 down through "ARTICLE" in line 1 on page 2 and substitute "<u>:</u>

(1) PLACE AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IN A PROMINENT AREA, ACCESSIBLE TO EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS; AND

(2) MAINTAIN THE FUNCTIONALITY OF THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR".

On page 2, after line 1, insert:

"(D) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER IMMUNITIES AVAILABLE UNDER STATUTORY OR COMMON LAW:

(1) <u>A GROCERY STORE OR RESTAURANT IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE</u> FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION IN THE PROVISION OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATION IF THE GROCERY STORE OR RESTAURANT HAS SATISFIED THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION;

(Over)

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(2) <u>AN INDIVIDUAL IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACT OR</u> <u>OMISSION IF:</u>

(I) <u>THE INDIVIDUAL IS ACTING IN GOOD FAITH WHILE</u> <u>RENDERING AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATION TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL</u> <u>WHO IS A VICTIM OR REASONABLY BELIEVED BY THE INDIVIDUAL TO BE A VICTIM</u> <u>OF A SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST;</u>

(II) THE ASSISTANCE OR AID IS PROVIDED IN A REASONABLY PRUDENT MANNER; AND

(III) THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATION IS PROVIDED WITHOUT FEE OR OTHER COMPENSATION; AND

(3) <u>A GROCERY STORE, RESTAURANT, OR INDIVIDUAL IS NOT</u> <u>CIVILLY LIABLE FOR FAILING TO RENDER AUTOMATED EXTERNAL</u> <u>DEFIBRILLATION TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A VICTIM OR IS REASONABLY</u> <u>BELIEVED TO BE A VICTIM OF A SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST.</u>";

and in line 2, strike "(C)" and substitute "(E)".
