BY adding to Article – Education Section 7–132 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 7-132.EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION TO STUDENTS,
