22(III) COMPLETED A MINIMUM OF 1,500 HOURS OF23POSTCERTIFICATION ADVANCED TRAINING HOURS OR PRECERTIFICATION HOURS24OF SERVICE AS A REGISTERED PSYCHOLOGY ASSOCIATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH25REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD; AND
