1 AN ACT concerning

 of the terms of certain appointed members of the Board and the appointment of
 certain members of the Board in a certain year; and generally relating to the
 Baltimore County Board of Education and member elections and appointments.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (a) The Baltimore County Board of Education consists of:
 - (1) Seven nonpartisan elected members;

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1 (i) The Governor may not appoint as a member of the county board 2 an individual who files a certificate of candidacy for election to the county board; and

3 (ii) An individual who files a certificate of candidacy for election to 4 the county board may not seek appointment to the county board by the Governor through 5 nomination by the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission.

7 (a) Except for the student member, a member serves for a term of 4 years 8 beginning on the first Monday in December after the member's election or appointment and 9 until a successor is elected or appointed and qualifies.

10 (b) (1) An individual who takes office to fill a vacancy for an elected or 11 appointed member serves for the remainder of the term for which the appointment was 12 made and until a successor is elected or appointed and qualifies.

13(2)The Governor shall act within 30 days to make any appointment to the14county board.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

16 (a) The terms of the four appointed members of the Baltimore County Board of 17 Education whose terms are scheduled to expire on December 1, 2026, shall terminate at 18 the end of December 1, 2024.

19 (b) The Governor shall appoint four members to the Board in accordance with § 20 3–2B–01 of the Education Article in 2024, and the four appointed members shall serve for 21 a term of 4 years beginning December 2, 2024, until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 23 1, 2023.
