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- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners to take 4 disciplinary action against an applicant or a licensee for failing to comply with a 5 Board order; prohibiting an order of the Board from being stayed pending judicial 6 review; authorizing the Board to appeal a decision that reverses or modifies its order; 7 authorizing the Board to reinstate a suspended or revoked license only in accordance 8 with the terms and conditions of the order of suspension or revocation or an order of 9 reinstatement issued by the Board; and generally relating to disciplinary actions by the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners. 10

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article – Health Occupations

24 3–313.

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Subject to the hearing provisions of § 3–315 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a



- 1 license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, with or
- 2 without conditions, or suspend or revoke a license, or any combination thereof, if the
- 3 applicant or licensee:
- 4 (28) Violates any provision of this title; [or]
- 5 (29) Fails to submit to a criminal history records check in accordance with §
- 6 3–302.1 of this subtitle; **OR**
- 7 (30) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY BOARD ORDER.
- 8 3–316.
- 9 (a) Except as provided in this section for an action under § 3–313 of this subtitle, 10 any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board in a contested case, as defined in the
- 11 Administrative Procedure Act, may petition for judicial review as allowed by the
- 12 Administrative Procedure Act.
- 13 (b) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board under § 3–313 of this
- 14 subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary but may take a direct judicial appeal as provided
- 15 in the Administrative Procedure Act.
- 16 (C) AN ORDER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT BE STAYED PENDING JUDICIAL
- 17 REVIEW.
- 18 (D) THE BOARD MAY APPEAL A DECISION THAT REVERSES OR MODIFIES ITS
- 19 ORDER.

- 21 IF A LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED OR REVOKED UNDER § 3–313 OF THIS
- 22 SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY REINSTATE THE LICENSE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH:
- 23 (1) THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE ORDER OF SUSPENSION OR
- 24 REVOCATION; OR
- 25 (2) AN ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT ISSUED BY THE BOARD.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
