27 28	(I) THAT IS TAX EXEMPT UNDER § 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE; AND

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- 1 (II) WHOSE MISSION IS TO DISTRIBUTE TO CHILDREN FREE, 2 HIGH-QUALITY BOOKS DESIGNED TO AID THE DEVELOPMENT OF READING SKILLS.
- 3 (4) "Program" means the Young Readers Matching Grant Program.
- 4 (b) There is a Young Readers Matching Grant Program in the [Division] 5 MARYLAND STATE LIBRARY AGENCY.
- 6 (c) The purpose of the Program is to provide grants to PUBLIC LIBRARIES AND affiliated services to:
- 8 (1) support SUPPORT the establishment and operation of affiliated 9 services; and
- 10 (2) <u>contribute CONTRIBUTE</u> an amount equal to the amount of funding provided for the operation of an affiliated service.
