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Vehicle Laws – Disabled Veteran Registration Plates – Issuance

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue <u>certain special</u> disabled veteran registration plates to certain disabled veterans; <u>prohibiting the</u> <u>Administration from charging certain persons the fee required for replacement</u> <u>registration plates under certain circumstances</u>; and generally relating to the

1 2. There is a field defect in which the peripheral field has 2 contracted to such an extent that the widest diameter of visual field subtends an angular 3 distance no greater than 20 degrees in the better eye;
