A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Gender–Affirming Treatment**
3 **(Trans Health Equity Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring, beginning on a certain date, the Maryland Medical
5 Assistance Program to provide medically necessary gender–affirming treatment in a
6 nondiscriminatory manner; requiring that the gender–affirming treatment be
7 assessed according to nondiscriminatory criteria that are consistent with current
8 clinical standards; prohibiting the Program from issuing an adverse benefit
9 determination related to gender–affirming treatment unless a health care provider
10 with experience prescribing or delivering gender–affirming treatment has reviewed
11 and confirmed the appropriateness of the determination; and generally relating to
12 gender–affirming treatment and the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
7 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Health – General**

9 15–103.

10 (a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance
11 Program.

12 (2) The Program:

13 (xx) Beginning on July 1, 2023, shall provide, subject to federal
14 approval and limitations of the State budget, community violence prevention services in
15 accordance with 15–141.3 of this subtitle; [and]

16 (xxi) Beginning on January 1, 2023, shall provide, subject to the
17 limitations of the State budget, and as permitted by federal law, coverage for self–measured
18 blood pressure monitoring for all Program recipients diagnosed with uncontrolled high
19 blood pressure, including:

20 1. The provision of validated home blood pressure monitors;
21 and

22 2. Reimbursement of health care provider and other staff
23 time used for patient training, transmission of blood pressure data, interpretation of blood
24 pressure readings and reporting, and the delivery of co–interventions, including
25 educational materials or classes, behavioral change management, and medication
26 management; AND

27 **(XXII) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2024, SHALL PROVIDE**
28 **GENDER–AFFIRMING TREATMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 15–151 OF THIS**
29 **SUBTITLE.**

31 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
32 **INDICATED.**

1 **(2) (I) “GENDER–AFFIRMING TREATMENT” MEANS ANY**
2 **MEDICALLY NECESSARY TREATMENT CONSISTENT WITH CURRENT CLINICAL**
3 **STANDARDS OF CARE PRESCRIBED BY A LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROVIDER FOR**
4 **THE TREATMENT OF A CONDITION RELATED TO THE INDIVIDUAL’S GENDER**
5 **IDENTITY.**

6 **(II) “GENDER–AFFIRMING TREATMENT” INCLUDES:**

7 **1. HORMONE THERAPY, HORMONE BLOCKERS, AND**
8 **PUBERTY BLOCKERS;**

9 **2. HAIR ALTERATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF ALTERING**
10 **SECONDARY SEX CHARACTERISTICS AND SURGICAL SITE PREPARATION;**

11 **3. ALTERATIONS TO VOICE, VOICE THERAPY, AND VOICE**
12 **LESSONS;**

13 **4. ALTERATIONS TO ABDOMEN, CHEST, TRUNK, AND**
14 **BUTTOCKS;**

15 **5. ALTERATIONS TO THE FACE AND NECK;**

16 **6. ALTERATIONS TO THE GENITALS AND GONADS;**

17 **7. LASER TREATMENT FOR SCARS FROM**
18 **GENDER–AFFIRMING TREATMENT;**

19 **8. STANDARD FERTILITY PRESERVATION PROCEDURES,**
20 **AS SET FORTH IN § 15–810.1 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE;**

21 **9. REVISIONS TO PREVIOUS TREATMENTS AND**
22 **REVERSAL OF TREATMENTS;**

23 **10. COMBINATIONS OF GENDER–AFFIRMING**
24 **PROCEDURES; AND**

25 **11. OTHER TREATMENTS AS PRESCRIBED TO SUPPRESS**
26 **THE DEVELOPMENT OF ENDOGENOUS SECONDARY SEX CHARACTERISTICS, ALIGN**
27 **THE INDIVIDUAL’S APPEARANCE OR PHYSICAL BODY WITH GENDER IDENTITY, AND**
28 **ALLEVIATE SYMPTOMS OF CLINICALLY SIGNIFICANT DISTRESS RESULTING FROM**
29 **GENDER DYSPHORIA.**

30 **(III) “GENDER–AFFIRMING TREATMENT” MAY INCLUDE**
31 **TREATMENT DESCRIBED IN THE CURRENT CLINICAL STANDARDS OF CARE FOR**

1 GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT PUBLISHED BY THE WORLD PROFESSIONAL
2 ASSOCIATION FOR TRANSGENDER HEALTH.

3 (3) "GENDER IDENTITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 20-101 OF
4 THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

5 (B) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT THE PROGRAM
6 PROVIDE GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT TO ALL PROGRAM RECIPIENTS FOR
7 WHOM GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT IS MEDICALLY NECESSARY, INCLUDING
8 TRANSGENDER, NONBINARY, INTERSEX, TWO-SPIRIT, AND OTHER GENDER DIVERSE
9 INDIVIDUALS.

10 (C) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR MEDICALLY
11 NECESSARY GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT IN A NONDISCRIMINATORY MANNER.

12 (2) THE GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT SHALL BE ASSESSED
13 ACCORDING TO NONDISCRIMINATORY CRITERIA THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH
14 CURRENT CLINICAL STANDARDS OF CARE.

15 (3) THE PROGRAM MAY NOT DENY OR LIMIT COVERAGE FOR
16 GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT WHEN THAT TREATMENT IS:

17 (I) PRESCRIBED TO A PROGRAM RECIPIENT BECAUSE OF,
18 RELATED TO, OR CONSISTENT WITH THE RECIPIENT'S GENDER IDENTITY;

19 (II) MEDICALLY NECESSARY; AND

20 (III) PRESCRIBED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT CLINICAL
21 STANDARDS OF CARE.

22 (4) THE PROGRAM MAY NOT DENY OR LIMIT COVERAGE FOR
23 GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT BASED ON THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT'S GENDER
24 IDENTITY.

25 (5) THE PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCLUDE GENDER-AFFIRMING
26 TREATMENT, INCLUDING REVISIONS TO PRIOR GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT,
27 ON THE BASIS THAT THE TREATMENT IS A COSMETIC SERVICE.

28 (6) THE PROGRAM MAY NOT ESTABLISH A CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION
29 FOR A PARTICULAR GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT.

30 (7) THE PROGRAM MAY NOT ISSUE AN ADVERSE BENEFIT
31 DETERMINATION DENYING OR LIMITING ACCESS TO GENDER-AFFIRMING
32 TREATMENT UNLESS A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER WITH EXPERIENCE PRESCRIBING

1 OR DELIVERING GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT HAS REVIEWED AND CONFIRMED
2 THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE ADVERSE BENEFIT DETERMINATION.

3 (D) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2024,
4 EACH MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT A
5 REPORT THAT INCLUDES:

6 (I) THE NAME AND LOCATION OF EACH HEALTH CARE
7 PROVIDER OFFERING GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT WITH WHICH THE MANAGED
8 CARE ORGANIZATION HAS AN ACTIVE CONTRACT; AND

9 (II) THE TYPES OF GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT PROVIDED
10 BY EACH HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.

11 (2) (I) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN
12 2025, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COMPILE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON GEOGRAPHIC
13 ACCESS TO GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT ACROSS THE STATE.

14 (II) THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE:

15 1. THE NAME AND LOCATION OF EACH HEALTH CARE
16 PROVIDER OFFERING GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT TO PROGRAM RECIPIENTS;

17 2. THE MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS THAT HAVE
18 ACTIVE CONTRACTS WITH EACH HEALTH CARE PROVIDER; AND

19 3. THE TYPES OF GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT
20 PROVIDED BY EACH HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.

21 (III) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH THE REPORT IN A
22 CONSPICUOUS MANNER ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE.

23 (3) THE DEPARTMENT AND EACH MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION
24 SHALL INCLUDE THE NAME, LOCATION, AND TYPES OF SERVICES FOR EACH
25 PROVIDER OFFERING GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT IN THEIR PROVIDER
26 DIRECTORIES.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 October 1, 2023.
