SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,16 That:

17 (h) (1) On or before September 1, 2020, the Commission shall submit an 18 interim report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with 19 § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

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1 (2) On or before December 1, [2023] **2024**, the Commission shall submit a 2 final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 3 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 5 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of [5] 6 years and 1 month and, at the end of 6 June 30, [2024] 2025, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, 7 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2023.
