1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland School for the Blind – Public School Construction Program –**
3 **Eligibility**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date on the eligibility of the Maryland School
5 for the Blind for certain funding under the Public School Construction Program; and
6 generally relating to the eligibility of the Maryland School for the Blind for funding
7 under the Public School Construction Program.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article – Education

11 Annotated Code of Maryland

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 8–315.

17 (a) Notwithstanding § 4–114 of this article and subject to regulations adopted by
18 the Interagency Commission on School Construction, [for fiscal years 2013 through 2028,]
19 the Maryland School for the Blind shall be eligible for funding under the Public School
20 Construction Program in accordance with Title 5, Subtitle 3 of this article.

1 (b) The Interagency Commission on School Construction shall adopt regulations
 2 for funding school construction and school capital improvements at the Maryland School
 3 for the Blind in accordance with the requirements set forth in Title 5, Subtitle 3 of this
 4 article that apply to school construction and school capital improvement projects funded for
 5 county boards of education.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
 7 1, 2023.
