4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Interagency Commission on School Construction to consider systemic renovation projects with a certain minimum construction cost as $\mathbf{5}$ 6 eligible for funding from the Supplemental Public School Construction Financing 7 Fund and the Supplemental Public School Construction Facilities Fund in certain 8 fiscal years; and generally relating to school construction funding for systemic 9 renovation projects.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16

19 Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), [and] (4), AND (5) of this (a) (1)20subsection, the Interagency Commission on School Construction shall, on a rolling basis, 21approve public school facility projects to be funded from the Supplemental Public School 22Construction Financing Fund and the Supplemental Public School Construction Facilities 23Fund

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1 (2) The first projects funded from the Supplemental Public School 2 Construction Financing Fund and the Supplemental Public School Construction Facilities 3 Fund shall be projects that the Interagency Commission on School Construction has 4 deemed eligible for funding but State funding for the projects has been deferred due to fiscal 5 constraints.

6 (3) The Interagency Commission on School Construction may not approve 7 a public school facility project that would reimburse a county for a public school facility that 8 has been completed.

9 (4) (i) Subject to the approval of the Authority, the Interagency 10 Commission on School Construction shall approve expenditures for eligible costs to be 11 reimbursed for a public school facility that begins construction on or after June 1, 2020.

(ii) Eligible costs in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph include items
eligible for State funding as provided in subsection (c) of this section.

14 (5) IN FISCAL YEARS 2024 THROUGH 2026, IF THE CONSTRUCTION 15 COST IS AT LEAST \$100,000, THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION ON SCHOOL 16 CONSTRUCTION SHALL CONSIDER SYSTEMIC RENOVATION PROJECTS AS ELIGIBLE 17 FOR FUNDING FROM THE SUPPLEMENTAL PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION 18 FINANCING FUND AND THE SUPPLEMENTAL PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION 19 FACILITIES FUND.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2023.
