Vehicle Laws - Parking Enforcement - Citations

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a parking citation issued by a political subdivision or a State agency to have printed on it a box that the person issued the citation may check to 4 5 indicate that the registration plates cited were not issued for the vehicle described 6 in the citation; requiring a political subdivision or State agency that receives a 7 parking citation from a person with the box checked to perform a certain 8 investigation and dismiss the citation under certain circumstances; prohibiting a 9 person from returning a parking citation to a political subdivision or a State agency with the box checked inaccurately; and generally relating to parking enforcement. 10

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) In this subtitle, "officer" means a police officer or a person other than a police



- officer who is authorized to issue a citation for a violation of an ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.
- 3 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, any State agency authorized by law 4 and any political subdivision of this State may adopt ordinances or regulations that:
- 5 (1) Regulate the parking of vehicles;
- 6 (2) Provide for the impounding of vehicles parked in violation of the 7 ordinances or regulations;
- 8 (3) Regulate the towing of vehicles from publicly owned and privately 9 owned parking lots; and
- 10 (4) Provide for the issuance of a citation by an officer for a violation of an ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.

- 13 (a) An officer who discovers a vehicle parked in violation of an ordinance or 14 regulation adopted under this subtitle shall:
- 15 (1) Deliver a citation to the driver or, if the vehicle is unattended, attach a citation to the vehicle in a conspicuous place; and
- 17 (2) Keep a copy of the citation, bearing his certification under penalty of perjury that the facts stated in the citation are true.
- 19 (b) In the absence of the driver, the registered owner of the vehicle is presumed 20 to be the person receiving the citation.
- 21 (C) (1) A CITATION ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A BOX 22 THAT THE PERSON ISSUED THE CITATION MAY CHECK TO INDICATE THAT THE 23 REGISTRATION PLATES CITED WERE NOT ISSUED FOR THE VEHICLE DESCRIBED IN 24 THE CITATION.
- 25 (2) A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR STATE AGENCY THAT ISSUES A
 26 CITATION UNDER THIS SECTION TO A PERSON WHO RETURNS THE CITATION WITH
 27 THE BOX CHECKED AS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- 28 (I) SHALL INVESTIGATE WHETHER THE PERSON ISSUED THE 29 CITATION SHOULD BE HELD LIABLE FOR THE VIOLATION; AND
- 30 (II) MAY CONTACT THE PERSON ISSUED THE CITATION AS PART 31 OF THE INVESTIGATION.

- 1 (3) AFTER AN INVESTIGATION INITIATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF
 2 THIS SUBSECTION, IF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR STATE AGENCY FINDS THAT
 3 THE PERSON ISSUED THE CITATION SHOULD NOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR THE
 4 CITATION, THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR STATE AGENCY SHALL DISMISS THE
 5 CITATION.
- 6 (4) A PERSON MAY NOT SUBMIT A CITATION WITH THE BOX CHECKED
 7 AS INDICATED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO A POLITICAL
 8 SUBDIVISION OR STATE AGENCY IF THE REGISTRATION PLATES CITED WERE ISSUED
 9 FOR THE VEHICLE DESCRIBED IN THE CITATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
