A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Resources and Education for All Prisons (REAP) Act**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services
4 to assist inmates in accessing certain federal education grants; requiring the
5 Maryland Department of Labor to set certain goals relating to inmates in education
6 programs and establish certain tracking systems relating to inmates in education
7 programs; requiring the State Department of Education and the Department of
8 Human Services to assist the Maryland Department of Labor in establishing certain
9 tracking systems; and generally relating to resources and education for inmates.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 **Article – Correctional Services**

24 **SUBTITLE 7. INMATE ACCESS TO FEDERAL PELL GRANTS.**

2 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ASSIST INMATES IN ACCESSING FEDERAL
3 PELL GRANTS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

4 (B) IN ORDER TO ASSIST INMATES IN ACCESSING FEDERAL PELL GRANTS,
5 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT WITH INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION,
6 INCLUDING:

7 (1) THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE;

8 (2) MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY;

9 (3) BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY;

10 (4) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND GLOBAL CAMPUS;

11 (5) ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE;

12 (6) HAGERSTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE;

13 (7) WOR-WIC COMMUNITY COLLEGE; AND

14 (8) GOUCHER COLLEGE.

16 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS

20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "INMATE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 1-101 OF
21 THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ARTICLE.

22 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

23 (1) SET GOALS FOR THE NUMBER OF INMATES IN EDUCATION
24 PROGRAMS;

1 **(2) ESTABLISH A TRACKING SYSTEM FOR THE NUMBER OF INMATES**
2 **IN EDUCATION PROGRAMS; AND**

3 **(3) ESTABLISH A TRACKING SYSTEM FOR THE PROGRESS OF INMATES**
4 **IN EDUCATION PROGRAMS, INCLUDING THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE CREDITS THAT**
5 **EACH INMATE EARNS IN AN APPROVED COLLEGE PROGRAM.**

6 **(C) THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF**
7 **HUMAN SERVICES SHALL ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT IN CREATING THE TRACKING**
8 **SYSTEMS UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.**

9 **(D) THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROVIDE FUNDING ANNUALLY IN THE BUDGET**
10 **BILL FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO USE FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS, INCLUDING**
11 **MARKETING FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS TO INMATES AND THE TRACKING SYSTEMS**
12 **FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS.**

13 **(E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS**
14 **SECTION.**

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2023.
